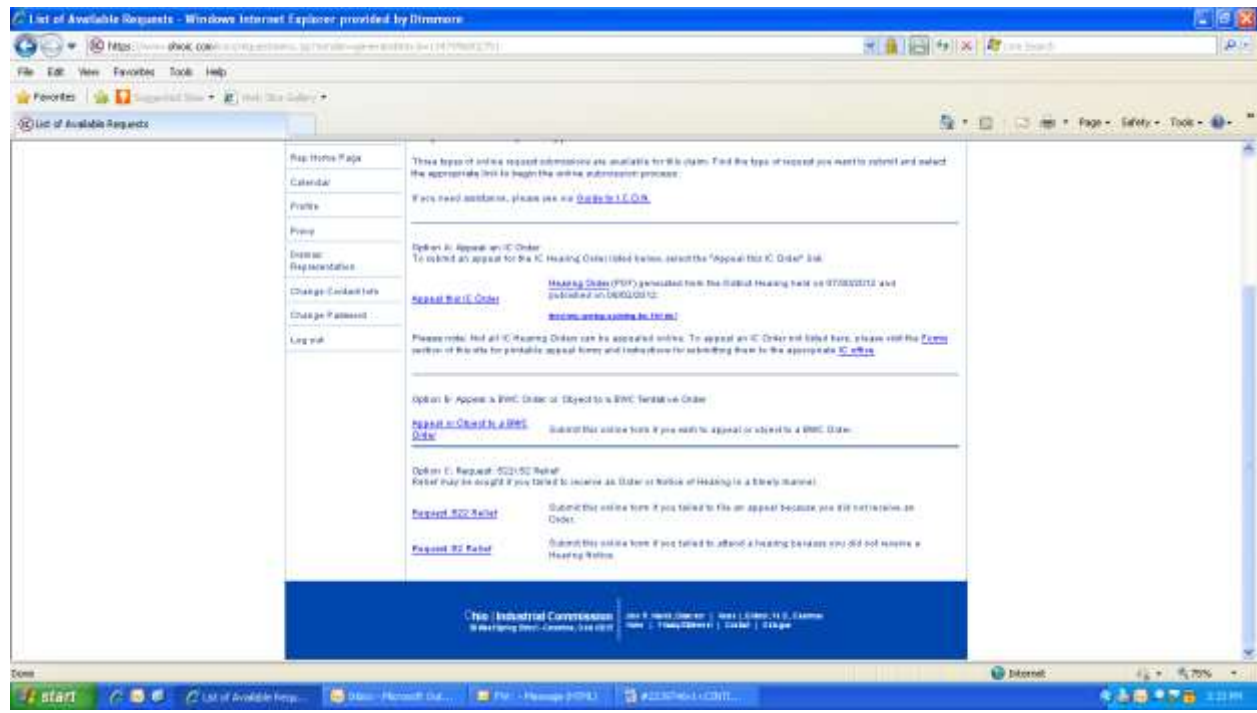


ICON SPECIFICS
