HBCU Scholars Program

Dinsmore believes in creating an environment where everyone has equitable access to the best the firm has to offer. Through the Dinsmore HBCU Scholars Program, the firm seeks to recruit and mentor outstanding 1L students affiliated with Historically Black College and University schools. The scholarship recipient will participate in Dinsmore's 10-week summer associate program. Additionally, the chosen recipient will receive a \$10,000 scholarship and will be eligible for an opportunity to return for a second summer and as a first year associate with Dinsmore, following graduation.

- Scholars with a strong record of academic or other achievement;
- Scholars who demonstrate an active commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion within their communities, through their professional and academic work, volunteerism, and/or other daily activities; and
- Scholars looking to enjoy the full Dinsmore experience by spending the entire summer with us.

- Excellent legal research and writing skills; and
